AMENDMENT TO THE BYLAWS OF SARDIS COVE HOMES ASSOCIATION

This is an Amendment to the Bylaws of the Sardis Cove Homes Association, a North Carolina nonprofit corporation. A Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for Sardis Cove was recorded May 9, 1981 in Book 4429, Page 165 of the Mecklenburg County Register of Deeds (the "Declaration"). Article XIV, Section 1 of the Bylaws states that the Bylaws may be amended with the affirmative vote of a majority of members present at any regular or special meeting of the members of the Association, at which the corporation's quorum requirement has been met.

By his/her signature below, the Association hereby certifies that this amendment was approved by the requisite percentage of owners casting votes at the annual meeting of the Association held on November 6, 2021.

WHEREFORE, Article VI, Section 2 is amended by striking and deleting the first full sentence of that section, and replacing it with the following:

"The Association shall be governed by a board comprised of seven individuals."

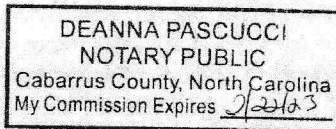
