- The Minutes from the June Board meeting were approved.
- The Homeowner Requests Log for July was reviewed, discussed, updated, and approved.
- The Financial Report for June was reviewed and approved.

Committee Reports

Treasurer: Continuing from earlier months in the year, there was some slight overspend in our building and maintenance budget. As we have previously discussed, this is in part to the general age of the community starting to show more prevalently. Additionally, you may see that we did not have our usual transfer to reserves included in the budget. While the monthly transfer did still occur, it takes around 3-4 days for it to reflect correctly in our account (which had not completed at the time of the report being generated). There will be a "larger" reserves deposit reflected next month as a result although the total sum is the same as it would be otherwise. All other budgets were in their expected allotments.

Capital Improvements: We are currently speaking with a prospective paving company to potentially come in and seal the roads. This would be in lieu of a full repaving of the community which at this time remains cost prohibitive. The sealing would allow for maintaining the longevity of the roadways while allowing us time to assess a more productive plan of action for any future roadwork. Additionally, we have received a quote for the aging retaining walls and will be discussing other alternatives with our maintenance person.

All other committees reported no unresolved issues at this time.
